Sir,

As per your instruction, I hereby submit the compliance report regarding the conduct of classes for 1st year MBBS from 23rd November 2020.

1. The Top committee for Covid-19 has been formed for sensitization, general preventive measures, preparatory work, crowd management, etc.
2. The 1st year students and the parents are informed regarding the commencement of classes from 23rd onwards. A webinar was conducted with the parents for the same.
3. The hostels are thoroughly sanitized, white washed and made ready for student accommodation as one student per room.
4. The Lecture galleries, Dissection hall, Demonstration rooms and Practical labs are kept ready for instructional classes, thoroughly sanitized.
5. Separate gate is used by the students.
6. Thermal scanners and sanitizer stands are kept ready at the entrance.
7. Social distancing, Wearing masks, using sanitizer, frequent washing of hands will be taken care of, as the students arrive and will be made a regular process.
8. A Psychiatrist is identified for counseling of the students.
9. Posters regarding the safety measures are being displayed in Telugu and English in the campus.
10. The students are instructed to get their own water bottles, books and other necessary items to avoid sharing.
11. Necessary arrangements were made to maintain physical distancing in the demonstration halls, Lecture gallery, Dissection hall, practical labs and Mess.
12. Sanitizers and soaps are provided in every room.
13. Students are instructed to install Arogya setu app.
14. On arrival, the students will be sensitized on the basic awareness on the COVID 19 as follows
 - a) To follow respiratory etiquette
 - b) Maintain Social distance of at least 6 feet
 - c) To wear a mask covering mouth and nose.

- d) To cough or Sneeze using a tissue or into a flexed elbow.
 - e) To wash hands thoroughly and frequently
 - f) Awareness regarding not to spread infection to the family members at home.
 - g) To take bath on going home and to be away from old people and others with comorbid conditions
15. 1% sodium Hypochloride solution is kept ready to disinfect at common public places and wash rooms.
16. Specific markings on the floor are made six feet apart in the corridors, staff rooms, reception areas and mess.
17. The students who are asymptomatic and those who are tested negative for COVID 19 are only allowed to join the hostels.
18. The classes will be conducted in small groups with the following precautions.
- a) Mask is made compulsory for the faculty, Non teaching faculty and the students.
 - b) Outdoor spaces like open auditorium, lawns are cleaned and kept ready for Faculty - student interaction with safety and physical distance in protocols.
19. Sports and extra-curricular activities are banned.
20. In case a student falls sick, necessary protocol will be followed.
However, online classes continue and those students, who cannot attend the classes physically, are asked to intimate the same and attend only online classes.
